

Clermont Soil & Water Conservation District Rain Garden Grant Application Program Form

Applicants are eligible to receive \$200.00 from the District to be used to help offset the cost of installing a rain garden. Funding will be provided only to individuals who are installing rain gardens which will reduce the quantity and/or improve the quality of storm water runoff. For example, disconnecting downspouts or other direct flows to the storm system, or treating runoff from a driveway or other contaminated surface would be high priority. Grants are offered on a reimbursement basis. Upon notification of acceptance, the applicant must complete the installation, and submit a photograph of the completed rain garden along with copies of receipts for materials, prior to reimbursement. Up to 10 grants will be awarded each year by the Clermont Soil & Water Conservation District. Grants will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis. Applicants must live or own property in Clermont County and be at least 18 yrs. of age. The Rain Garden must be installed in Clermont County and be completed within eight (8) months of grant approval. Applicants must have permission to install the rain garden from landowner(s), homeowner association, and/or applicable parties. Applications can be made via mail or in person to Clermont Soil & Water Conservation District Office, 1000 Locust St., Owensville, OH. 45160.
